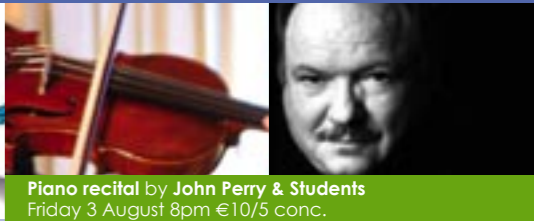
**Clare Youth Theatre Summer Workshop**

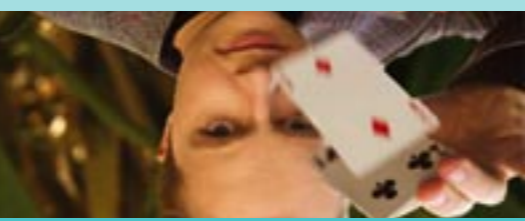
**Crafty Kids Art & Craft Workshop**

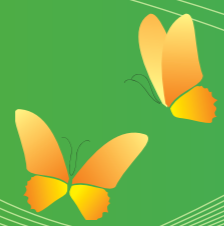
**The Silver Surfari**
