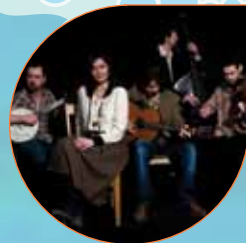

The Gloaming is a collective of remarkable individual talents who share a musical aesthetic. The five came together to explore new music at Grouse Lodge Studios in Westmeath in early 2011. At once they made music that is at once both ancient and utterly new. New York pianist Bartlett, sean-nós singer Ó Lionaird, Chicago guitarist Cahill, fiddler and hardanger innovator Ó Raghallaigh and fiddle master Hayes is a group of virtuoso musicians, yet it is a band with a sound all of its own.
